The Batesburg-Leesville Chamber of Commerce and the Town of Batesburg-Leesville are proud to announce this year's Christmas Parade and Tree Lighting ceremony will be held on Sunday, December 10th starting at 5:30pm. *Peace on Earth* has been selected as the theme for this year's event.

To close the evening, Mayor Lancer Shull will light the Town Christmas Tree and lead those attending in a candle light rendition of Let There Be Peace on Earth.
