Job duties:

- Monitors and performs all daily plant operations.
- Start up, shut down, perform moderate lifting, regulate and adjust motors, pumps, compressors, grinders, blowers, valves and other apparatus to meet changing operating conditions.
- Collects and prepares water and samples for laboratory analysis; performs lab test and prepares laboratory reports.
- Regulate and adjust chemical rates as indicated.
- Assist in ensuring plant compliance with Town/department policies and procedures, S.C.DHEC regulations, and other applicable laws, regulations, and standards of quality and safety.
- Perform general clerical work as required, including preparing records and reports, completing forms, copying and filing documents, entering and retrieving computer data, answering the telephone, etc.

Qualifications:

- High School diploma or GED equivalent
- Must possess a South Carolina Waste Water Treatment license of grade C or better.
- Must be available to respond after hours and weekends for emergency operational purposes.
- Ability to prepare simple reports
- Valid SC Driver's License
